In addition to teaching at Trinity, he also serves as a lecturer with the U.S. Center for World Missions and has conducted seminars for pastors in China and Eastern Europe.

Dr. Magary received the Bachelor of Arts from Fort Wayne Bible College, the Master of Divinity from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, and the Master of Arts and the Doctor of Philosophy in Hebrew and Semitic studies from the University of Wisconsin at Madison.

Dr. Magary's areas of expertise include Hebrew, Aramaic, Old Testament poetry and wisdom, and computer applications for Old Testament studies. He is a member of the Evangelical Theological Society, the Society of Biblical Literature, and the National Association of Professors of Hebrew.

Dr. Magary and his wife, Pamela, reside in Vernon Hills, Illinois. They have three married children and six grandchildren. In his spare time, Dr. Magary enjoys biking.

Dr. Magary's publications include chapters contributed to *Seeking Out the Wisdom of the Ancients* (which he also co-edited) and *Preparing to Preach the Old Testament*.
