



马爱默博士 (Elmer A. Martens, Ph.D.)

马爱默博士著有《耶利米书释经》。他是美国加州费雷斯诺 (Fresno) 的门诺弟兄会圣经神学院 (Mennonite Brethren Biblical Seminary, 现名为 Fresno Pacific Biblical Seminary) 的旧约名誉教授。他曾在日本、印度、韩国、俄罗斯、肯尼亚、巴西、刚果、加拿大的许多神学院和大专院校授课, 也在美国三一神学院 (芝加哥)、美南浸信会神学院 (路易斯维尔)、以及富勒神学院 (帕萨迪纳) 讲课。

马爱默博士所著的 *God's Design: A Focus on Old Testament Theology* (暂译为《上帝的设计: 聚焦旧约神学》, 1997年, 第三版,) 已在美国 (由 Baker) 和英国 (由 InterVarsity) 出版。他与 Gerhard Hasel 和 Ben C. Ollenburger 共同编辑了 *The Flowering of Old Testament Theology* (暂译为《旧约神学之发展》, Eisenbrauns, 1992年)。Jon Isaak 为向马滕斯博士致敬而编撰了 *The Old Testament in the Life of God's People* (暂译为《旧约与神子民之生命》, Eisenbrauns, 2009年)。马博士也曾参与 *New American Standard Bible* (新美国标准译本) 圣经的翻译, 并协助 *New King James Version* (新英王钦定本圣经) 的翻译。

马爱默博士于克莱蒙研究生院 (Claremont Graduate School) 获旧约博士学位, 他完成的博士论文题为“*Motivations for the Promise of Israel's Restoration to the Land in Jeremiah and Ezekiel* (暂译为《论耶利米书和以西结书里以色列蒙应许重返圣地的原因》)”。他是 Saskatchewan 大学文学学士, Manitoba 大学的教育学士。他毕业于美国加州费雷斯诺的门诺弟兄会圣经神学院, 现为“北费雷斯诺门诺弟兄会 (North Fresno Mennonite Brethren)”的会友。

马爱默博士教授圣经, 关注教会整体的灵性健康。八年的牧会经历更使他热爱神的子民, 他渴望看到信徒在基督里生命持续成长, 从而能够承传神的宣教使命。

**Elmer A. Martens (Ph.D.)**

Elmer A. Martens, author of *Jeremiah*, is Professor Emeritus of Old Testament and President Emeritus of Mennonite Brethren Biblical Seminary, Fresno, California (now Fresno Pacific Biblical Seminary). He has taught in seminaries and colleges in Japan, India, Korea, Russia, Kenya, Brazil, Congo, Canada, and in the United States at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School (Chicago), the Southern Baptist Seminary (Louisville), and Fuller Theological Seminary (Pasadena).

Dr. Martens wrote *God's Design: A Focus on Old Testament Theology* (3d ed. 1997) published in the U.S. (Baker) and Great Britain (InterVarsity). He is editor (with Gerhard Hasel and Ben C. Ollenburger) of *The Flowering of Old Testament Theology* (Eisenbrauns, 1992), and recipient of an honorary volume edited by Jon Isaak, *The Old Testament in the Life of God's People* (Eisenbrauns, 2009). He served on the translation team of the New American Standard Bible and assisted with the New King James Version.

Dr. Martens holds a doctorate in Old Testament from the Claremont Graduate School, where he completed a thesis on "Motivations for the Promise of Israel's Restoration to the Land in Jeremiah and Ezekiel." He has a BA degree from the University of Saskatchewan, and a BEd from the University of Manitoba. He is a graduate of the Mennonite Brethren Biblical Seminary in Fresno, California, and a member of the North Fresno Mennonite Brethren congregation.

Dr. Martens is a Bible teacher with a concern for the spiritual well-being of the church at large. His eight years of pastoral experience have given him a love for God's people and a desire to see believers maturing in Christ in order to carry forward God's mission. He is married to Phyllis Hiebert Martens, herself a writer. They have four children.
