



## 格拉厄姆·科尔博士 (Graham A. Cole, Th.D.)

格拉厄姆·科尔博士先后毕业于悉尼大学 (文学学士与神学硕士)、伦敦大学 (道学学士)、摩尔神学研究院 (文学文凭), 以及澳洲神学研究院 (神学士 [Licentiate in Theology] 和神学博士)。他的第一份职业是在新南威尔士教育局担任管理员。在接受了早期的神学教育后, 他被按立成为一名圣公会牧者, 并在两个教区服事。他的博士研究课题是威廉帕雷的伦理哲学与神学 (18 世纪研究)。他曾在摩尔神学研究院开设的基督教思想课程中讲学 (神学、护教学与哲学), 并在悉尼大学的宗教哲学课上授课。他曾在 1992 年至 2001 年间担任墨尔本大学莱德里学院院长, 并同期教授基督教思想。他曾是墨尔本大学顾问委员会成员。2002 至 2011 年之间他在位于伊利诺伊州德菲尔得 (Deerfield) 的三一神学院担任圣经神学及系统神学教授。2011 年, 他受位于阿拉巴马州伯明翰的桑福德大学毕森神学院邀请, 出任圣公宗道学教授。

科尔博士曾在下列杂志发表他的文章: *Churchman, Expository Times, Enlightenment and Dissent, The Philosopher, Tyndale Bulletin, Reformed Theological Review, Journal of Anglican Studies, Journal of Christian Education, Zadok, Themelios* and the *Southern Baptist Journal of Theology*.

他参与著作的书籍和字典包括: IVP's *New Dictionary of Christian Ethics and Pastoral Theology, New Dictionary of Apologetics* and *New Dictionary of Theology Revised* as well as, the *Baker/SPCK Dictionary for the Theological Interpretation of The Bible*.

他写作了两部论圣灵的著作, 分别是 *Engaging With the Holy Spirit: Real Questions, Practical Answers* 和 *He Who Gives Life: The Doctrine of the Holy Spirit*, 并一部论赎罪的专著 *God the Peacemaker: How Atonement Brings Shalom*。他的最新作品是 *The God Who Became Human: A Biblical Theology of the Incarnation*。世界三大洲上都留下了他讲道、教授神学的足迹。此外, 他还在澳大利亚及美国的文学期刊上发表了一些诗作。

Dr. Graham Cole is a graduate of the University of Sydney (BA and M. TH), the University of London (BD), Moore Theological College (Dip. A) and the Australian College of Theology (Th.L and TH. D).

He began his professional life as an administrator in the New South Wales Department of Education. After his initial theological training he was ordained as an Anglican minister and served in two parishes. His doctoral work was done on William Paley's moral philosophy and theology (eighteenth century studies). He lectured in Christian Thought (Theology, Apologetics and Philosophy) at Moore Theological College and at the University of Sydney in the Philosophy of Religion. From 1992 to 2001 he was the Principal of Ridley College, University of Melbourne and lecturing in Christian Thought. He has served as a member of the Council of the University of Melbourne. He was Professor of Biblical & Systematic Theology at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, Deerfield, Illinois, U.S.A from 2002-2011. In 2011 he was invited to become the Anglican Professor of Divinity, Beeson Divinity School, Samford University, Birmingham, Alabama, U.S.A.

He has published articles in *Churchman*, *Expository Times*, *Enlightenment and Dissent*, *The Philosopher*, *Tyndale Bulletin*, *Reformed Theological Review*, *Journal of Anglican Studies*, *Journal of Christian Education*, *Zadok*, *Themelios* and the *Southern Baptist Journal of Theology*. He has contributed to many books and dictionaries including IVP's *New Dictionary of Christian Ethics and Pastoral Theology*, *New Dictionary of Apologetics* and *New Dictionary of Theology Revised* as well as, the Baker/SPCK *Dictionary for the Theological Interpretation of The Bible*.

He is the author of two books on the Holy Spirit: *Engaging With the Holy Spirit: Real Questions, Practical Answers* and *He Who Gives Life: The Doctrine of the Holy Spirit* and one on the atonement *God the Peacemaker: How Atonement Brings Shalom*. His newest book is *The God Who Became Human: A Biblical Theology of the Incarnation*. He has preached and taught theology on three continents. He has also had poetry published in a number of Australian and American literary journals.

He is married to Jules a dress designer, author and a teacher of fashion at college level. He enjoys films, books, food, fishing and sport in general. He has three grown children, two daughters-in-laws and two grandsons.
